Guardian Angels Usher's Meeting

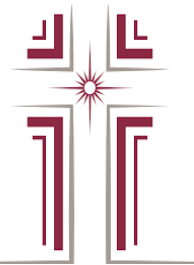
Jesus said, "Whoever receives you, receives me, and whoever receives me receives the One who sent me" (Matthew 10:40).

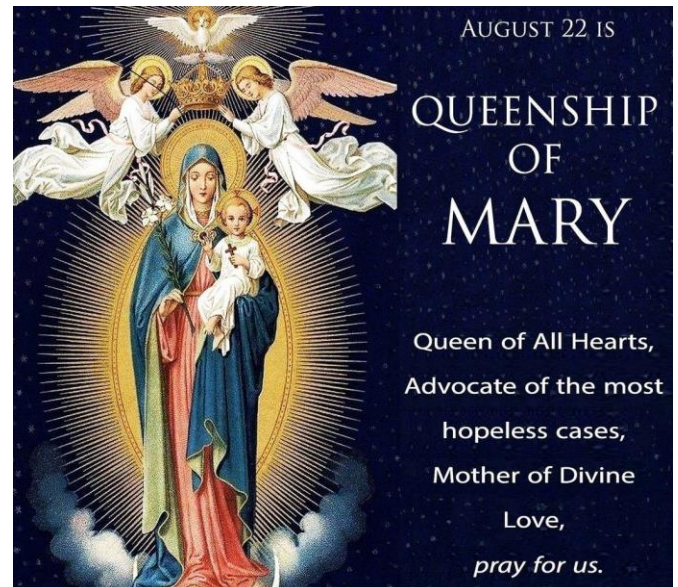
